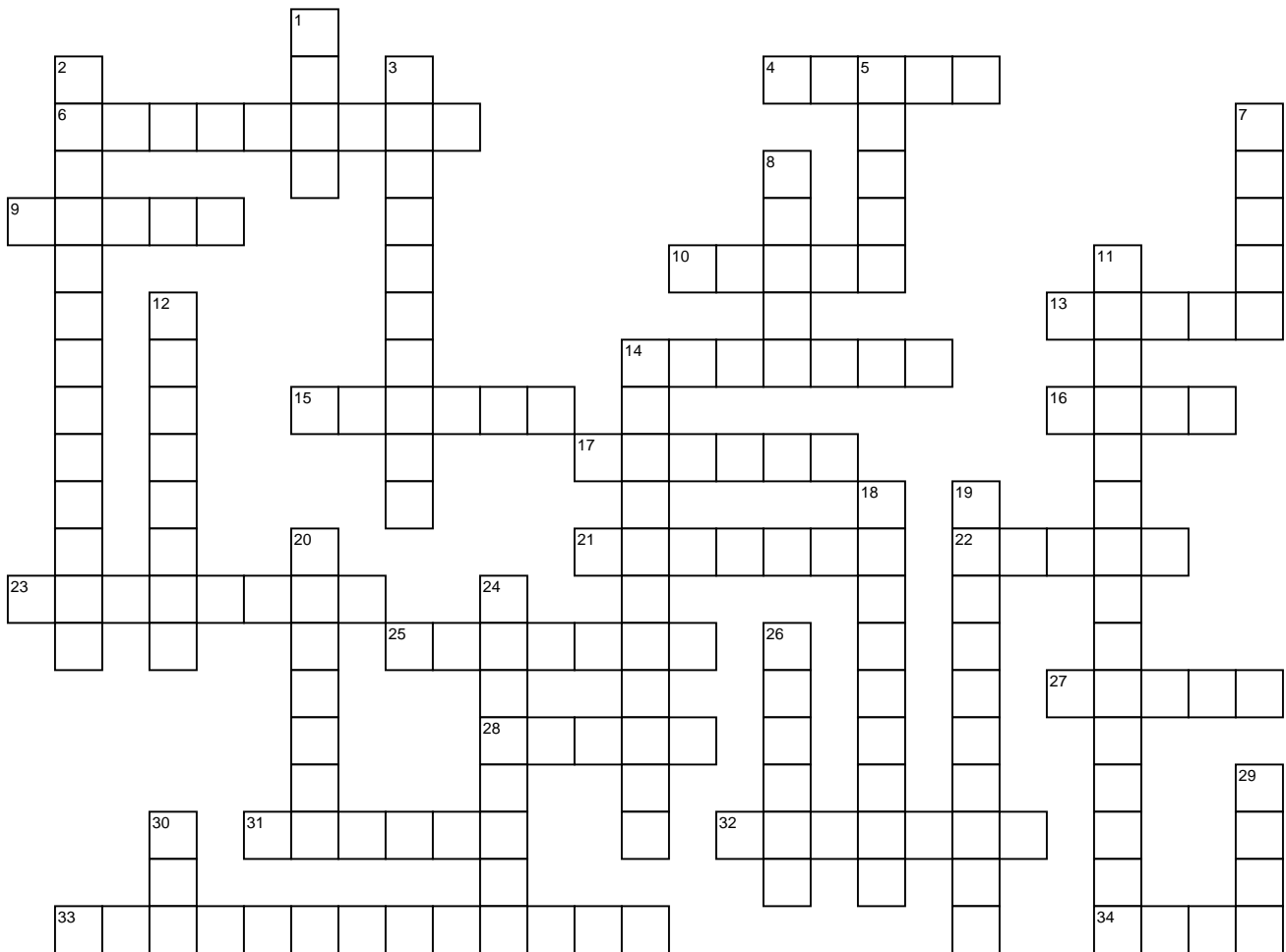

ACROSS

- 4** Where Jewish exiles assembled with Ezra when about to return to Jerusalem, Ezra 8
6 Where Necho king of Egypt fought Charchemish, 2 Chron. 35
9 Also known as the Mediterranean Sea, Ezra 3
10 Where the king of Assyria carried Israel away captive, 2 Kings 17
13 Hezekiah diverted some of its water for Jerusalem, 2 Chron. 32
14 Naaman thought it was better than the Jordan river, 2 Kings 5
15 The Israelites crossed it on dry ground, Josh. 3
16 Called the "salt sea" in the Bible, but not actually named, Deut. 3, Josh. 15, Josh. 18
17 Where Elijah had 450 prophets of Baal killed, 1 Kings 18
21 The apostle Paul sailed it, Acts 27
22 Thought not only to be a district, but also a river where captives were taken, 2 Kings 18
23 Same as the sea of Galilee, John 6
25 God told Elijah to hide there, 1 Kings 17
27 Boundary between Ephraim & Manasseh, Josh. 17
28 The main river of Damascus, 2 Kings 5
31 On the border of Ammon, Reuben & Manasseh, Josh. 12
32 Where Jesus called Peter and Andrew, Matt. 4

- 33** Not actually named in the Bible. It is called the "great sea", Num. 34, Josh. 1, 9, 23
34 Its name is not found in the Bible but a baby was hidden in it, Exod. 2

- 1** Daniel had a vision here, Dan. 8
2 Also known as the salt sea, Deut. 3 (4w)
3 Where Jesus taught while sitting in a boat, Luke 5
5 On the border of Moab, Judg. 11
7 The first river named in Eden, Gen. 2
8 "Thy plants are gone over the sea," Jer. 48
11 Where the Jews sat down and wept over Zion, Psa 137 (3w)
12 Where Daniel saw a vision, Dan. 10
14 Also known as the "great sea." Exod. 23
18 Paul sailed it, Acts 27
19 Boundary of Israel on the north & east. Known by several names, Num. 34
20 Where the Jordan River ends, Josh. 18 (2w)
24 A river in the tribe of Dan, Josh. 19
26 Where Ezekiel saw a living creature, Ezek. 10
29 Used figuratively as a lake, Rev. 20
30 Where an army drowned, Exod. 15
