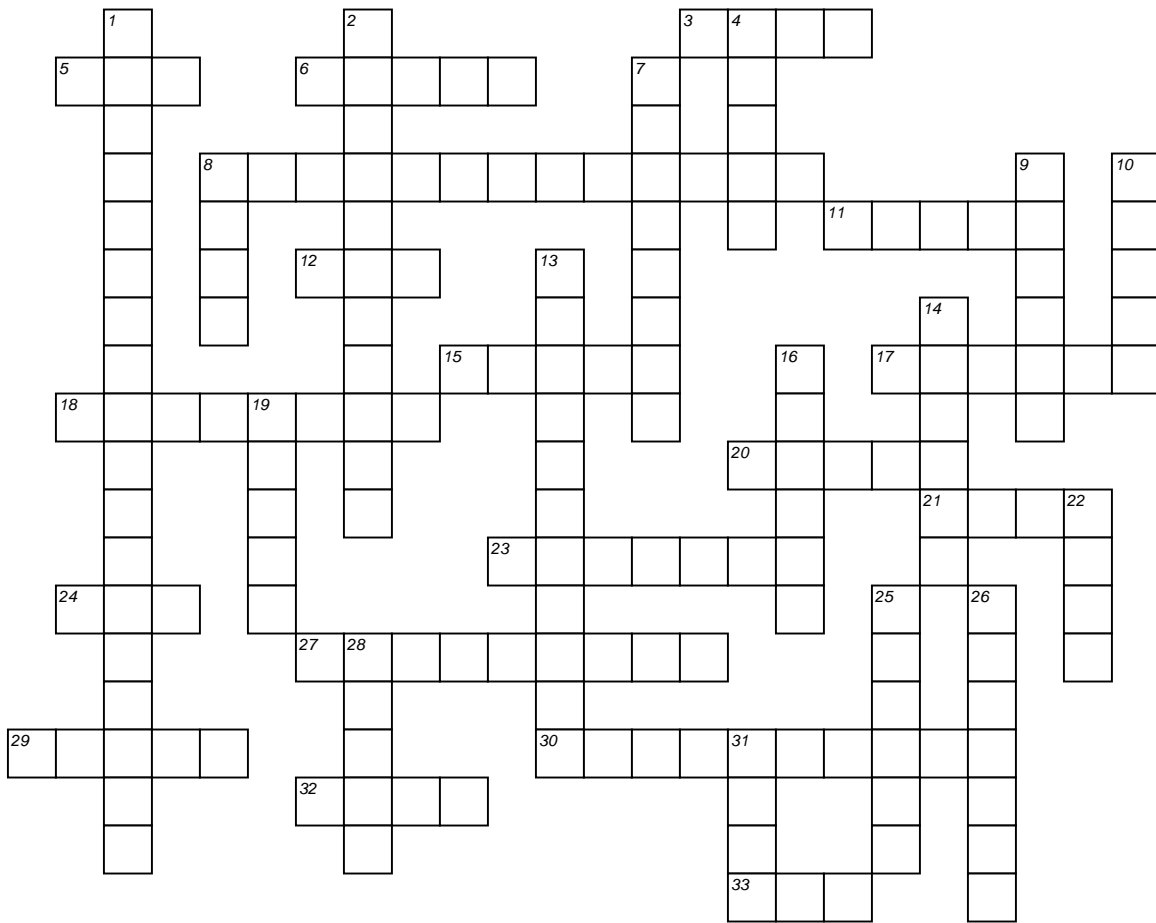


# Weights, Measures & Money

## ACROSS

- 3** About 9 inches, from the point of the thumb to the point of the little finger, 1 Sam. 17
- 5** A dry measure, 1 quart, 2 Kings 6
- 6** 2.5-3 pounds, 80-100 shekels, Ezek. 45
- 8** 140-146 feet (2w), Zech. 2
- 11** A weight & a coin, 1/2 shekel (half weight), 1/4 once, 10 gerahs, Exo. 38
- 12** 2/3 of 1 pint -1 pint, Lev. 14
- 15** Denarius, penny, Luke 7
- 17** Weight or measure of money, often of silver or gold. Largest weight among the Hebrews. 60 manehs, Matt. 25
- 18** 1/4 cent, less than 1/2 cent, Matt. 5
- 20** 1/40 once (11 grains), smallest Hebrew weight, Num. 3
- 21** About 2 quarts, 1 & 4/5 cabs, Exo. 16
- 23** A certain amount, maybe 1.5 pecks, 2 Kings 7
- 24** A dry measure, 10 baths, Ezek. 45
- 27** 1/10 part (2w), Lev. 23
- 29** Denarius, pence, day's labor, Matt. 20
- 30** About 1/4 ounce (2w), Exo. 30
- 32** 5 gallons & 1 pint, some say 8 gallons & 3 quarts, 6 hins, Ezek. 45
- 33** 1 gallon & 1 quart, 12 logs, Lev. 23

- 1** 2,000 paces or cubits, about 3/4 of a mile (3w), Acts 1
- 2** 20-30 miles (2w), 1 Kings 19
- 4** 14-16 ounces, Luke 19
- 7** Scales, Ezek. 45
- 8** 1/8 cent, 2 mills, Mark 12
- 9** Unit of money, Lev. 5
- 10** About 18 inches, from the point of the elbow to the point of the middle finger, Judges 3
- 13** About 3-3.5 inches, width of 4 fingers, 2 Chron. 4
- 14** About 6 feet, a stretch of the arms, Acts 27
- 16** Unit of weight (other weights were regulated by it), 1/2 ounce, 2 bekahs, Gen. 24
- 19** A dry measure, 10 ephahs, nearly 8 bushels, Hosea 3
- 22** About 9-10 feet, 6 cubits, Ezek. 40
- 25** About 9 gallons, John 2
- 26** 1/8 mile, Luke 24
- 28** Measure for grain, about 1 bushel, Amos 8
- 31** A certain measure, maybe 1.5 pecks (found in NKJV), 2 Kings 7
